

Children's Ministry Leadership Cohort In-Person Retreat and Zoom Hybrid

What's Included? Join a group of up to twelve women and men for a unique leadership development experience. We'll begin with a 3-day retreat in downtown Louisville. We'll eat great food, get to know one another, and dive into the first 5 sessions of our cohort. Jared and Trey will tag-team the sessions for the retreat, and at the end you'll have an opportunity to ask them anything before heading home and digging into the rest of the cohort.

Post-retreat you'll have 6 conference calls. You will learn to assimilate and train volunteers, build a child protection policy for your church, and partner with parents. Our goal is that you will be developed as a theologically driven, gospel-centered, mission-focused children's ministry leader.
