Need-to-Know Information for the January 15-17, 2024, Retreat in Louisville, KY:

Transportation: You do not need to rent a car. Several of us will be driving. We'll meet at the hotel each morning to carpool over to the meeting location (TBD), and we'll also carpool for meals. If you want to do more exploring during your downtime, you're welcome to Uber or walk if the destination is nearby (coffee, food, etc.).

Money for Meals: We'll cover a catered dinner for the group Monday night during our time together, and also take care of dinner out Tuesday night. You can snag breakfast at the hotel each day before our meetings kick off each morning. We'll have snacks and drinks (we'll reach out to get your favorites!) for you during our time together as well. The only meal you should expect to pay for during the retreat is lunch on Tuesday as we'll be splitting up and letting you explore some spots in NuLu with each other.

Hotel Stay: We're planning to reserve a block of rooms at Home 2 Suites in the NuLu area of downtown (240 S Hancock St, Louisville, KY). We'll have more booking details soon! Please let us know if you're making other lodging arrangements so that we can reduce the number of rooms we have reserved.

Sunday, January 14, 2024

Monday, January 15, 2024 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday)

If you arrive early in the day, there's plenty of great ways to spend time in downtown Louisville. I'd suggest checking out the Louisville Slugger Factory, the Frazier Historical Arms Museum, or the Muhammad Ali Center. All are a short Uber away from your hotel. On MLK Day, the Ali Center typically shows Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s "I Have A Dream" speech at 11am.

- **5:30pm** Meet in the lobby of the Home 2 Suites to carpool to the meeting site (TBD) for our opening session. We'll have a catered dinner, open the Scriptures together, get to know one another, and we'll talk through expectations and desires for the cohort.
- Homework for Opening Night: Take a few minutes to write key moments in your personal journey to ministry. Where'd you come from (family of origin)? When and how did you come to faith in Jesus? What brought you into your current ministry role? What Bible passages have been significant in your growth as a Christian and a leader? What do you hope to get out of the cohort? We'll spend time sharing this with the group so we can get to know each other.
